

Theism

- 1. God exists
- 2. Man is a creature of body/soul
- 3. There is good and evil
- 4. Our destiny is eternal life, eternal death, or annihilation.



Atheism

God doesn't Exist

Man is nothing but matter

There is nothing really good and evil. Morality is a matter of taste.

Our destiny ends with death.



Pantheism

All is God

Man is God and pure spirit

Good and evil are an illusion.

Our destiny is to be absorbed with the ONE.

Avicenna on Contradiction

 Anyone who denies the law of non-contradiction should be beaten and burned until they realize that to be beaten is not the same as not to be beaten, and to be burned is the same as not to be burned.

Truth


 Identity between what you say and what is.

Presuppositions
